Transfer Credit Policy: Courses sponsored by a college or university but taught at high schools by high school teachers in classes composed primarily of high school students will not be considered for transfer credit at Tulane, even if a college transcript is issued for these courses.

- 1. The course was listed in official catalog of the college or university from which you earned credit.
2. The course was composed primarily of degree-seeking college student.
3. The course was taught by faculty of that college/university on that institution's campus.
4. You earned a grade of C or above in the course.

Instructions: List those courses that meet all all of the conditions enumerated above. Attach copies of course descriptions from college catalog (s) and send the documents to: Academic Advising Center- 211 Stanley Thomas Hall-Tulane University-New Orleans, LA 70118-5698.

Request an official transcript from the College or University awarding the credits and have it sent to the Associate Dean's Office.

Complete and send the enclosed Transfer Credit Eligibility Form Supplement to the Registrar's Office of any college or university from which you earned allowable credit.

No transfer credit can be evaluated until all of these materials have been received. Materials received after August 1st may be too late to meet advising and registration deadlines. Courses will be evaluated for transfer to Tulane by the Office of Undergraduate Admission.
