

DECLARATION AND CERTIFICATION OF FINANCES

(REQUIRED FOR NON US CITIZEN APPLICANTS ONLY)

Please note: Tulane University will not issue an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility, which is essential to obtain a United States visa, until this form has been officially certified and returned to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. The purpose of this form is to certify that you can provide the approximately \$69,814 per year necessary for tuition cost and living expenses during the school year. You should certify the maximum dollar amount you and your family can comfortably contribute on a yearly basis, up to \$69,814.

Regardless of the amount certified, students can be equally considered for merit and need-based scholarships. The maximum need-based financial aid awarded by Tulane to international students is \$20,000 per year. The Financial Aid Application can be found at profileonline.collegeboard.com. The maximum merit-based award (requiring strong SAT or ACT scores) is \$51,010. Merit-based awards may require a separate application, visit admission.tulane.edu/aid/merit for more information. The maximum combined award to a student by Tulane may not exceed \$51,010. Therefore, you should certify that you can provide at least \$18,804 (= \$69,814 minus \$51,010). If the amount you certify combined with merit and need-based scholarships we are able to offer is below \$69,814, we may not be able to offer admission to our undergraduate program.*

The information provided on the Declaration and Certification of Finances must be true and accurate. The inclusion of false information is grounds for dismissal from Tulane. Failing to submit the form in a timely manner could delay your admission, registration, and visa. Please be aware that a student visa does not permit you to work off campus in the United States.

*International transfer applicants must certify that they can provide at least \$49,814.
